- **Ages:** 36 - 47 months
- **Reggio Emilia Approach** to teaching and care.
- Developmentally Appropriate, High Quality Care:
- **Active, Hands-On, Open-Ended Play & Exploration.** Three Year Olds will spend more time in the atelier where they will continue building on the investigative skills they learned in the Two Year Old program.
- **Open Ended Projects incorporating science, art, arithmetic, language, reading, and writing** allow for connecting new ideas and skills to what Threes already know and can do. Building upon what they learned from the Two Year Old program and drawing connections to new information is how Teachers help your child build knowledge. Teachers also connect learning to objects or themes that interest your child.
- **Observation & Documentation.** Teachers will observe children to discover how they learn and what they know and enjoy. Teachers will use this information to extend children's learning. By documenting what three year olds are doing and saying through photographs, videos, notes, assessments, and recordings will allow teachers to evaluate the information they collect about children to decide what experiences to give children next.
- **Adding Small Challenges** to activities so that children's skills keep growing. Teachers will offer suggestions that will encourage the threes to learn new skills and how things work in the world around them.
- **Defined Areas.** The classrooms will be divided into separate areas for sleeping, playing, eating, and learning. That way, everything and everyone stays clean and safe.

# Three Year Old Program continued...

- **8:1 Teacher to Child Ratio.** Each three year old classroom will have 16 children with 2 Teachers monitoring the children at all times. Teacher aides will also be present to ensure that this ratio is always met.
- **Potty Training.** Three year olds will be continue their potty training that began in the toddler program. Teachers will work with parents to ensure potty training success for each child.
- **Detailed Weekly Reports** & Hi Mama and Kinderlime apps will be used for Parent-Teacher communication. Teachers will provide information to parents about each three year old's toileting, eating, sleeping, daily activity, and picture updates throughout the day.
- **Safety & Security.** Video Monitoring. The Director will be monitoring the classrooms at all times with constant classroom check-ins as well as through video cameras in the classroom.
